

# Prerequisites for Qualifying Examinations and Membership Level Explanation

#### **Teacher Candidate:**

- · Shall be a minimum of 18 years of age.
- · Have completed 2 years of responsible teaching or apprentice teaching.
- $\cdot$ \_Present a biographical letter indicating past dance experience, schooling, performing, professional experience, and teaching background.
- · Shall hold CCA Teachers' Grade I Certificate before applying for Teacher Membership.

### Teacher member:

- · Shall hold CCA Teachers' Grade I Certificate, and be a member in good standing.
- · Have completed 2 years of responsible teaching of the Grades.
- · Passed CCA Teachers' Grade II, III, or IV Examination.

Graded examinations encompass syllabus, anatomy, music, and history for each level.

### **Associate member:**

- · Be a minimum of 20 years of age
- · \_Shall hold Teacher CCA Grade Certificates I-IV
- · Have at least three years of responsible ballet teaching experience in the Cecchetti method.
- · Passed Teacher Elementary (V) examination.
- · ACCA members may use the term "qualified" in advertising

## Licentiate member:

- · Be a minimum of 22 years of age
- · \_Shall hold Teacher CCA Grade Certificates I-IV, and Teacher Elementary (V).
- · Have at least six years of responsible ballet teaching experience in the Cecchetti Method
- · \_Passed Teacher Intermediate (VI) examination
- · May sponsor Teacher Candidates
- · LCCA members may use the term "certified" in advertising

## Fellow member:

- · Be a minimum of 28 years of age
- · Shall hold Teacher CCA Grade Certificates I-IV, Teacher Elementary, and Teacher Intermediate
- · \_Shall have at least eight years of responsible ballet teaching experience in the Cecchetti Method
- · Passed Teacher Advanced (VII) examination
- · Passed Teacher Final Diploma examination
- · DFCCA members may use the term "Diploma Fellow" in advertising
