Housing Information

Students are housed in Kollen Hall. The mailing address is PO Box 9000, Holland MI, 49422-9000. The main campus number is 616-395-7000. The CCA Office is located within Kollen Hall: Office hours are 8:00 – 12:00; 1:00 – 5:00; and 6:00 – 10:00. The Residence Halls provide double occupancy with twin beds, clothes chests, and desks in each room. Linens are provided with a linen exchange offered on the first Saturday. Laundry facilities are available. Food, soft drinks, and appliances such as refrigerators and microwaves are not allowed. Check-in is on Sunday between 12:00 noon and 4:30. Dinner is served in Phelps Dining Hall at 5:00. The student schedule book and adjudication times will be given at registration. Orientation meetings will be held after dinner on Sunday. Student Etiquette and Behavior

The behavior policies and regulations are set by Hope College and the CCA for the safety and comfort of all. Students who do not abide by the regulations will be sent home without refund.

The Curfew is as follows: Students must be on their own floor at 9:30, in their own room at 10:00, and must have lights out at 10:30. Phone calls are not allowed after 10:00. Full-time counselors will enforce curfew policy. Students 18 years and over must be willing to comply with CCA Housing Rules.

Proper Studio Etiquette is expected. Students may not enter class late or leave class without permission. Food, drink, and gum are not allowed in the studios. Talking or disruptive behavior during class is not permitted. Cell phones must be turned off before entering the classroom and may not be used until after leaving the dance buildings. Students are expected to attend every class. Daily attendance is taken for every class and workshop rehearsal.

Class Placement

Students will be adjudicated for level placement by CCA and Guest Faculty Members. Placement decision is based upon the students' demonstrated abilities. There will be no refunds offered for students leaving the program because of level placement dissatisfaction.

Additional Information

Scholarships: Students of Grade IV level and above may participate in the scholarship audition. Students of active CCA members may complete an application and submit the \$20 participation fee at registration. The tuition award must be used for the following year's Summer Program.

Performance: There will be two performances at the Knickerbocker Theatre located on 8th Street in downtown Holland on the final Saturday. The CCA provides performance skirts for all levels.
