Returning this year is the Cecchetti Council of America's Men's Training Program, a comprehensive training program devoted to the development of the physiological, technical and artistic capabilities of the classically- trained male dancer. Dancers within the Men's Training Program will take a daily "Men's Class" while integrating classes focused on the performance of Men's Variations, the development of flexibility, strength training/conditioning, pas de deux, pantomime, as well as modules in disciplines such as turning, petit allegro and more. With multiple levels, the program provides participants at the beginning stages of their training with excellent fundamentals to advance their knowledge of classical ballet, while providing more seasoned dancers with additional tools to further their careers within the art from. Male participants will be mentored by an all-male staff in addition to the exceptional faculty of the Cecchetti Council of America's summer intensive program.

Curriculum

Classical Ballet, Pointe, Variation, Pas de Deux, Character, Jazz, Improvisation, Mime, Performance Workshop, with Lecture Topics including: Dance History, Nutrition, and Injury Prevention & Care.

Dancers of all levels will participate daily in two ballet technique classes, one dance related class, and one performance rehearsal. As part of the program dancers in the B levels will receive pointe. Upper Levels will receive pointe, partnering, and variations.

All Classical Ballet classes will be accompanied by accomplished piano musicians.

Housing & Supervision

Students requesting on campus housing must be 11 years old by December 1, 2018.

Adult supervised housing will be provided for dancers on the campus of Hope College. A full nutritional meal plan with three meals per day is provided. The Residence Hall is within walking distance of all classes and provides double rooms, linen service, and laundry facilities. All students will be chaperoned by adult counselors throughout the Course.

Summer School Cost:

Tuition: \$710, Room: \$475, Meals: \$475, Student Total: \$1,660 Transportation is provided from the Grand Rapids Airport for a one-way fee of \$40. The additional fee must be included in final payment. Transportation fees are nonrefundable for any reason.

The Dow Health and Physical Education Center on campus offers an indoor swimming pool, track, and a fully equipped conditioning room. All activities will be chaperoned.

Acceptance Requirements

Participarts are expected to be outstanding students of dance. By signing the application, the sponsoring teacher recommends the applicant for our program. Students must maintain the highest standard of conduct at all times.

Application must be completed indicating years of serious training; number of ballet classes currently taking per week; and, if applicable, the last CCA exam passed.

Two 4x6 photographs in solid colored leotard and pink tights must accompany application. Photographs must show two poses: tendu a terre to the second position (arms in second) and first arabesque. Photographs will be used to assess applicants for acceptance and level placement.

Final class placement will be determined according to the dancers' demonstrated ability. Decision of the class placement adjudicators is final and not subject to discussion.
