Guest Faculty

Lisa Carducci-Deringor is a choreographer and master teacher. Originally from Detroit MI, Lisa studied classical ballet and holds grades I-Advanced from The Cecchetti Council of America. Lisa has performed lead roles in *The Sleeping Beauty, Cinderella* and Coppelia. At the age of 19 Lisa moved to Los Angeles where she received a dance scholarship at Tremaine Dance Center. She has studied many disciplines under some of the industry's top teachers and choreographers. Following the scholarship, she began working as a professional dancer and choreographer. She has performed on the MTV Video Music Awards, Billboard Awards, HBO Comedy Awards, tours, videos, film and commercials. She has worked with such artists as Brittany Spears, N'sync, Lenny Kravitz, Taking Back Sunday and James Blunt. She has also worked with companies such as HBO, Pepsi, Disney, Adidas, TJ Maxx and Marshalls. Lisa resides in Williamsburg VA, where she is the Creative Director of The Movement Dance Company, Artist Manager and teacher at The Institute for Dance.

Jennifer Goodman was born in Romeo, Michigan and received her training in the Detroit area under the direction of Mary Kashinsky, Mary Geiger, and Cornelia Sampson. After graduating from high school, she attended the Joffrey summer program on scholarship, subsequently joining The Joffrey II Dancers. A year later she joined The Joffrey Ballet, with which she continued her career over the next 16 years. With The Joffrey, Jennifer toured internationally with the world renowned rock-ballet Billboards and appeared in Robert Altman's film The Company. Jennifer has performed an extensive repertoire including principal and soloist roles in ballets by Gerald Arpino, Robert Joffrey, George Balanchine, Antony Tudor, Leonide Massine, Agnes de Mille, Vaslav Nijinsky, Vicente Nebrada, Frederick Ashton, Jerome Robbins, John Cranko, Twyla Tharp, Paul Taylor, Pilobolus, and had a role created for her by Donald Byrd. She has performed numerous roles in Robert Joffrey's The Nutcracker including Clara and The Sugar Plum Fairy. Jennifer left the Joffrey in 2009 to pursue a freelance career, subsequently performing with the Metropolitan Opera, The Lyric Opera of Chicago, Chicago Opera Theater, The Dallas Opera, San Diego Opera, Ballet X, Avi Scher & Dancers, Ballet NY, and RPM Productions. Jennifer still performs occasionally as a guest artist and is also currently a ballet teacher and certified yoga instructor.
