Guest Faculty

Megan Coleman Stuart - Originally from Taylor, Michigan, Megan Stuart began training with Patricia Squire Lorenz and Leif Lorenz at Ballet Americana. She has also trained locally with Samantha Shelton and Christina Kammuller, as well as Lisa Mayer of Toledo Ballet. Megan has also trained at The David Howard Summer Intensive, The Bolshoi at Vail, American Ballet Theatre, Joffrey Midwest, and with Ballet Met. As a dance student at Eastern Michigan University, she won The National Society of Arts and Letters Career Award for ballet. Megan began her professional career with Ballet Theatre of Ohio where she had the opportunity to dance the roles of the Sugar Plum Fairy, Snow Queen, and Arabian in "The Nutcracker," Wicked Witch of the West in the premier of "The Wizard of Oz," Lilac Fairy in "The Sleeping Beauty," and many contemporary works in the Heinz Poll Summer Dance Festivals, including "One" by Joseph Morrissey. In the winter of 2010, she was invited to perform with Verb Ballets, in Cleveland, OH. Megan recently finished her sixth season with the Lexington Ballet where she has performed Dew Drop, Don Quixote Pas de Deux, Fairy Doll, Swanilda in "Coppelia", the title role in "Cinderella", the Evil Witch in "Snow White", the Queen of Hearts in "Alice in Wonderland", and many original works by director Luis Dominguez. She has had the pleasure of being a guest ballet instructor for The University of Michigan's musical theatre department, Eastern Michigan University, and have been on faculty for Lexington Ballet School, Christine Jones- Meneer School of Dance (school for Ballet Theatre of Ohio), and Toledo Ballet, along with many schools nationally.

Natalia De Miguel Annoni - Natalia is a dancer and choreographer from Toledo, Ohio. Natalia graduated from Eastern Michigan University in 2019 where they received a bachelor in dance. Natalia has had works performed at the Gala showing at American College Dance Association, Kristi Faulkner's show *Women's Work*, Sean Hoskins' show *shape//matter*, *Detroit Dance Exchange* and Fun Girl Dance Company's show, *Ypsi Dance Swap*. Natalia is currently a teacher at Randazzo Dance Studio and River Raisin Dance Academy, and is also entering the third year dancing professionally with Fun Girl Dance Co.

Syllabi classes will be presented by CCA Examiners; Non Syllabus I/II by Eastern Michigan Committee members.
