

Ballet Day Event Policies

- Absolutely no refunds for any reason.
- Accommodations cannot be made for students wishing to be placed in the same class.
- Classes with fewer than 6 pre-registered students are subject to cancellation.
- For the safety of the dancers and staff, parents must wait in designated waiting areas and not directly in the areas around the dance spaces.
- NO PHOTOGRAPHY OR VIDEO RECORDING, except by designated CCA personnel, is permitted in the dance rooms during class.
- Walk-in registration will be accepted, if space is available.

Dress Code

Female-identifying dancers:

- Hair must be off the face and neck and secured to the head (bun, French twist, or other classical style).
- Dancers must wear a solid black one-piece leotard, pink tights, and ballet shoes. Pointe shoes may be worn for Non-Syllabus 5+ as well as syllabus classes where appropriate.
- No skirts for Grades I-IV.
- Ballet slippers, any type of jazz/lyrical/contemporary shoe, or dance socks may be worn for contemporary classes.

Male-identifying dancers:

- Longer hair must be secured off the face and neck.
- Dancers must wear white T-shirt, black tights or jazz pants, a dance belt, and ballet shoes.
