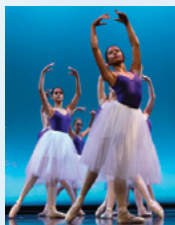

Curriculum

Classical Ballet, Pointe, Variations, Contemporary, Performance Workshop, with Lecture Topics that may include: Dance History, Nutrition, and Injury Prevention & Care.

Dancers of all levels will participate daily in two ballet technique classes, one dance related class, and one performance rehearsal. As part of the program dancers will receive pointe. Upper Levels will receive pointe, and variations.

All Classical Ballet classes will be accompanied by accomplished pianists. All students will have the opportunity to participate in a Pizza Party/Talent Show.

Housing & Supervision

Students requesting on campus housing must be 11 years old by December 1, 2024.

Adult supervised housing, in a **non-air conditioned** student dorm, will be provided for dancers on the campus of Hope College. A full nutritional meal plan with three meals per day is provided. The Residence Hall is within walking distance of all classes and provides double rooms and laundry facilities. **Hope College has discontinued its linen service for the student summer school.** If unable to provide your own linens, contact wjmerkle@comcast.net. All students will be chaperoned by adult counselors throughout the Course.

Summer School Cost:

Tuition: \$975, Room: \$625, Meals: \$600, Student Total: \$2,200

Transportation is provided to and from the Grand Rapids Airport for a one-way fee of \$60. The additional fee must be included in final payment. Transportation fees are nonrefundable for any reason.

Scholarships

Scholarship auditions are open to all student course participants.

A \$20.00 audition fee is payable the day of registration. Presentation of scholarship recipients will be made at the special awards ceremony Friday, July 19, 2024.

Performance

The Summer School culminates with a free public performance on Saturday, July 20, 2024, at the Knickerbocker Theatre, Holland, MI.

Acceptance Requirements

Participants are expected to be outstanding students of dance. By signing the application, the sponsoring teacher recommends the applicant for our program. Students must maintain the highest standard of conduct at all times.

Application must be completed indicating years of serious training; number of ballet classes currently taking per week; and, if applicable, the last CCA exam passed.

Two 4x6 photographs in solid colored leotard and pink tights must accompany application. Photographs must show two poses: tendu a terre to the second position (arms in second) and first arabesque. Photographs will be used to assess applicants for acceptance and level placement.

Final class placement will be determined according to the dancers' demonstrated ability. Decision of the class placement adjudicators is final and not subject to discussion.

TEACHER SEMINAR ~ July 21-27, 2024

Cecchetti Council of America welcomes all teachers to our seminar to explore, learn, and study the Cecchetti Method of ballet training. The Cecchetti Method offers teachers a balanced and analyzed system of theory and execution for the planned development of the ballet student from the first lesson to the professional levels. Taught by guest faculty and CCA Examiners, classes and lectures will encompass CCA student levels (Primaries and I-IV) as well as the professional Cecchetti syllabi (Elementary, Intermediate, Advanced, and Diploma).

All teachers can learn and share knowledge in a positive and friendly atmosphere provided by the CCA and Hope College. The conference is devoted to the art of teaching, emphasizing developing technique and the quality of movement, body placement, and style.

The Teachers Conference runs concurrently with the 2024 Cecchetti International Classical Ballet Competition. Classes will be scheduled to include teacher attendance at CICB Competition events, allowing teachers the opportunity to view international and national student competitors in adjudicated classes and performances on the stage of the Jack Miller Auditorium.
