Adjudicator Bios



Fiona Cameron-Martin Born in Hong Kong, Fiona moved to Melbourne, Australia, where she trained at the Australian Ballet School with Irina and Sergei Konstantinov, Ai-Gul Gaisina, Margaret Wilson, Slava Zalomski, Xiuyun Tang, Jiahong Wang, Lisa Pavane, Leigh Rowles and Marilyn Rowe. She then completed her education with private training under the watchful eyes of ex-Bolshoi Ballet soloist dancers Yulia and Maxim Vasilyev. Fiona then moved to Europe and danced professionally for the Romanian National Ballet and the New English Ballet Theater, dancing in numerous classical, neoclassical, and contemporary works. In her career, she danced a variety of soloist roles in ballet such as "Le Corsaire" by Vasili Medvedev, "Classical Symphony" by Yuri Possokhov, "DSCH" by Alexei Ratmansky, "La Sylphide" by Johan Kobborg, "Manon" by Sir Kenneth MacMillan, "Themes and Variations" by George Balanchine, "Petit Mort" by Jiri Kylian, and "In the Middle Somewhat Elevated" by William Forsythe. She also danced corps de ballet roles in almost all of the ballet classics. Fiona launched her teaching career at Southold Dance Theater in 2016 and was promoted to Assistant Artistic Director and Children's Coordinator in 2020. In her time at Southold Dance Theater, Fiona has carefully curated the curriculum to cover all levels, from Creative Dance through to the Pre-Professional Company. Her curriculum is based on the Russian Vaganova system, the syllabus she was taught in her training. Fiona has been a guest teacher at the Interlochen Center for the Arts (Michigan), Indiana Ballet Theater (Indiana), River Raisin Ballet (Michigan), and The Arts of the Dance Center (New Jersey). She is also a regular master teacher at the Caledonia Dance & Music Center (Michigan). In 2018, Fiona was a judge and master teacher at the Dance Masters of Michigan. In recent years, dancers Fiona has trained have gone on to be finalists and win prizes at international ballet competitions such as the Prix de Lausanne and the Youth American Grand Prix. She now proudly has students dancing professionally at Kansas City Ballet and Milwaukee Ballet and dancing in colleges such as the University of Utah, the University of Cincinnati Conservatory of Music, and the University of Michigan.



Judy Rice is a graduate of the National Ballet School of Canada and has performed extensively across the US, Canada and Europe with the Joffrey Ballet, The National Tap Dance Company of Canada, and American Ballet Comedy. She has 35 years of experience teaching for regional companies and festivals as well as Company Dance, DMA, DEA, CNADM, SADM, The Joffrey Ballet School, The Joffrey Ballet, Steps, the Dance Teacher Magazine Summer Conference and The Dance Teacher Summit. Rice has been a judge for ADA, HEADLINERS and has been on the faculty for Dance Masters Teacher Training School and CNADM teacher training school. She was a contributing writer to GOLDRUSH magazine. In May of 2000 she co-founded Behind Barres, and to date they have produced 11 albums of ballet class music, which was featured on ABC's hit show Lost, and have also released 7 educational DVD's. Rice's television credits include Fame, All my Children, The Tonight Show Starring Johnny Carson and the Great American Dance Challenge. Since 1990 she has been an Associate Professor of Performing Arts at the University of Michigan and has been on the faculty at Broadway Dance Center, Pace University and Peridance in NYC. Rice has also been an ambassador for lululemon athletica and featured on the cover of Dance Teacher Magazine, September 2013. She has served as private ballet coach for Katie Holmes, Amy Adams, and Amy Acker and as assistant to Tyce Diorio for his choreography for SYTYCD, Season 9. Rice has been a special guest for Dance League, Encore Expo, NUVO and 24/Seven. She has been on faculty for Company Dance, ASH, and Industry Xperience dance conventions. Last year, the University of Michigan honored Rice by being the inaugural recipient of the School of Music, Theater and Dance teaching excellence award. Most recently she is the Co-founder and director of Alpha Dance Convention.



Wilfredo Rivera is a rare Latino artist serving as a full-time choreographer and arts leader. Wilfredo was born in Honduras, trained with Hubbard Street Dance Chicago, and was a founding member of River North Dance Chicago. Mr. Rivera was honored with the 2009 Cliff Dwellers Arts Foundation Choreography Award, a 2001 After Dark Award, nominated for a 3ARTS Award in 2017 and 2018, and the recipient of a 2021 black album mixtape award for his multi-cultural work. In Chicago, Mr. Rivera's concert work has been featured at The Auditorium Theatre, The Chicago Symphony Center, Chicago Jazz Festival, Hyde Park Jazz Festival, Harris Theater, Ruth Page Center for the Arts, DuSable Museum, Reva, and David Logan Center for the Arts, Links Hall and Old Town School of Folk Music among others. Theatrical choreography includes productions for Goodman Theatre, Teatro Vista, Bailiwick Theatre, Metropolis Arts Center, Columbia College, American Theater Co., Porchlight Theater, The Artistic Home, Pegasus Players, American Players Theater, Forward Theater in Wisconsin and Chicago Aerial Dance. He is the Artistic Director & CEO of the critically acclaimed Cerqua Rivera Dance Theatre (CRDT). Rivera also serves as Musical Theater Program Coordinator & Dance Practitioner in Residence for Columbia College Chicago. He's looking forward to taking CRDT on tour this Spring as the Co. celebrates its 25th Anniversary Season.
