# **CICB Competition 2024 Audition Guidelines**

Students auditioning for the CICB 2024 Classical Ballet Competition may do so in person, at the CCA Ballet Festival which will be held February 10-11, 2024 in Clinton Twp, Michigan, or by video submission. The videos will be adjudicated the weekend of the Festival by the same guest adjudicators.

Juniors must have passed Elementary and be 14-16 years of age by July 21, 2024 Seniors must have passed Intermediate and be 17-20 years of age by July 21, 2024

All competitors must be a student and not a professional dancer (i.e. anyone who is employed as a full time dancer with a professional dance company. This includes dancers who are not currently employed but have been in the past).

Students must choose a Classical Variation (see attached list) and prepare a Contemporary Solo to be performed barefoot, or with footwear of Choreographer's choice, not to exceed 2 minutes.

# In Person Requirements

Students will attend an adjudicated class on stage. The class will be unset apart from the following exercises:

Juniors - 1<sup>st</sup> set of Port de Bras and the Elementary Adage Enchainment Seniors - 2<sup>nd</sup> set of Port de Bras and either Pas de Chaconne for female identifying students, or Coupé et Fouetté for male identifying students.

The Students will then perform both their Classical Variation and Contemporary Solo in full costume so the adjudicators can see exactly how they will be costumed at the CICB competition should they be selected.

Students attending the festival may also enter the open competition for solo and group pieces with opportunities to earn scholarships for summer intensives around the country. The festival includes classes for students and teachers taught by CCA faculty (formerly EMC Ballet Days), auditions, and performance opportunities.

- Once you have registered you will be sent video submission instructions.
- The video must be taken in a well lit space large enough to comfortably perform the variation and contemporary solo.
- The student should not wear the same color leotard and tights as the background of your space, so they can be clearly seen throughout.
- The full body must be in frame at all times.
- ◆ The camera should be as close to the center as possible giving the adjudicators a clear en face perspective of the dancing.
- Title the video with the students first and last name, and their age.
- Registration must be submitted by January 1, 2024
- Videos must be submitted by January 20, 2024

# **Attire**

#### Classical Variation and Contemporary solo

All students should perform in full costume so the adjudicators can see how they will be costumed at the CICB competition should they be selected.

#### Classwork

Female identifying students should wear pink or skin colored tights, a solid colored leotard, and pointe shoes.

Male identifying students should wear solid color tights, a solid colored leotard or tightly fitted shirt that allows the adjudicators to clearly see the body, and ballet slippers.

- Seniors Female identifying students Pas de Chaconne
  Male identifying students Coupé et Fouetté

#### **Pirouettes**

◆ A waltz turning enchainment that contains multiple pirouettes from 4<sup>th</sup> position, both en dehors and en dedans

#### Tours

- Female identifying students Fouetté turns
- ◆ Male identifying students Turns in 2<sup>nd</sup>

#### Petit Allegro

◆ An enchainment that includes batterie

#### Grand Allegro

◆ An enchainment that includes grand allegro such as Grand Jetés, Fouetté sautés, Grand assembles, Cabrioles, etc.

#### Coda

- Female identifying students a diagonal of turns including piqués, petit soutenus and petit tour
- ◆ Male identifying students a 2<sup>nd</sup> grand allegro including double tour en l'air and entrechat six
